DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

This corner was found by Forestry Division survey orew while making a partial resurvey of this township. Found what I believe to be the government corner as located by Delmore Teed in 1901 and used by C. E. Stackus in 1927. Teed's witness stumps a Y. Pine 18 N54W 7½ and a W. Pine 16 N38W 42 are in place. Roots of the government corner tree in place, and remains of SE CBT. Could find no iron as set by Stackus, but it could have been pulled out, since corner is only 6 feet from old wagon road. Corner checks exactly with government chainage north to swamp and good to lake south. Distances E & W along town line are irregular between corners, but should be expected since this is very rolling terrain.
