B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:		
F5 – ¼ Corner common to Sections 9 & 16, T23N, R10W - No evidence of GLO witnesses. Could find no evidence of A. J. Teeds Hemlock post. From 'E5' measured grid distance N89°56'19"E 1311.16' (1321.98' - AJT) to Fd. 1" iron bar in Mon. Box in No. 29 ¼ Rd. at W 1/16 Corner common to Section 9 & 16 that is accepted as A. J. Teed's position per 1885 Survey. Thence continued N89°56'19"E 1311.16' (1321.98' – AJT) to a "doubled over position that falls on the NW side of a 21" S. Maple w/ ancient E-W fence remains through it. Ancient E-W fence being 1' to 2' South. Thence S89°58'24"E 2635.37' (2640' – GLO, 2655.84' – AJT) to 'G5'. "Doubled over position" is N17°29' W 2.12' of straight line single proportion to A. J. Teed distances. Felt fitting historical monuments and occupation to the West was best solution for corner 'F5'.
