C13 & C1 — Standard Section Corner common to Sections 31 & 32, T24N, R12W & Sections 5 & 6, T23N, R12W — Find a bent 5/8" rebar in Monument Box that fits witnesses per 1997 Pullen LCRC. 0.1' North of 5/8" rebar find ½" CIR #25869 in same Monument Box. Removed Monument Box & irons and excavated corner location. Found a 1 ½" rusty iron bar or pipe — 1.5' down — being 0.35' South of the surface 5/8" rebar's location. During the excavation found a broken off piece of the rusty 1¼" iron surrounded by 3 ½" dia. x 8" long concrete cylinder that appears to fit the 1935 description. This appears to have broken off the fd. 1¼" iron. 1 ½" iron is 0.5' South of the physical centerline of the E-W Bit. Road. Witnesses #1 through 11 are gone, #13 is dead. 1 ¼" iron accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
