

down 1' – on S. Edge of Manistee River Bank – 1' S. of River. Fd. Remains of both of Fargo's BT's mostly gone that fit Mon. Found
3 witnesses by Wilcox and remains of 2 others; the distance to Cedar at N80°E being 10' longer than record. Fargo established position by double proportion to GLO. Wexford Co. Mon. accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner.


