A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:			
E9 – 1839 – GLO Survey by J. Brink, set post 1) Beech 12" N3°W 24; 2) Cherry 8" S56°W 25 - 1913 – E. E. Sours, County Surveyor, Survey in Section 29, No description or witnesses given. Distance West 2696', distance South 2657.5' 2006 – LCRC – L. 7, p. 55 – J. R. Davidson – Found no evidence of GLO or of the corner used by Sours. Position of corner was based on the retracement of the 1913 Sours survey. Set 5/8" iron with Wexford County Brass Cap at the intersection of a line from 'C-9' through 'D-9' on North Section line and a line from 'E-11' through 'E-10' on the East section line. This position is 31' South of a downed barbed wire fence to the West. Distance West measures 2684.12' (2696' – Sours) distance South measures 2641.00' (2657.5' – Sours). 5/8" iron with Wexford County brass cap is careful and faithful reestablishment of the Sours position and the position of the original corner. 5/8" iron with Wexford County brass cap stamped: 46659, 2006, 20, 21, 28, & 29. 3) N04°E Twin 8" Maple 34.63'; 4) N78°W 10" Ironwood 4.34'; 5) S14°E 8" Cherry 8.82'; 6) S85°E 6" Twin Cherry 20.21'			
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:			
E9 – Section Corner common to Section 20, 21, 28 & 29 – Fd. 1 ½" Wexford County Brass Cap per Davidson LCRC. This position is 34'± South of intersection of fence remains in Maple Tree (#3) that go W, N, & SSE'ly. A retracement of the fence to the West finds that the fence is 33' ± 2' North of E. E. Sours positions ¼ & ½ miles to the West. The position at 'E11' that was used to establish the longitudinal position for 'E9' has since been revised. Based on the solution per remonumentation LCRC - L. 7, p. 55 the corner position would moved S83°36'W 1.65'. This would move the existing monument west of the line of the old fence remains to the North. Could see no good reason to revised the existing remonumentation position. Wexford Co. Monument accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
