I, Thomas L. Sutherland, in a field survey on 11/12/99 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent resortation:
- G.L.O., 1819, Field Notes
 - 1) 30" W.O. S84°E 81 Links
 - 2) 18" W.O. N57°W 80 Links

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- Found 3/4" x 16" iron pipe on North edge of gravel 6" below surface surrounded by large rocks. Dug down 22" to large rock too large to remove. Reset new 3/4" x 16" iron pipe with aluminum remonumentation cap stamped 24620 over large rock and replaced rocks previously removed from hole around new pipe. This was the second iron as described in Section A.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- 3/4" x 16" iron pipe with aluminum remonumentation cap stamped 24620 over large rock, surrounded by smaller rocks at North edge of gravel 6" below surface.
 - 3) 20" dead Cherry S65°E 72.04 to Nail
 - 4) 14" Cherry S45°E 47.30 to remon tag on SW Side
 - 5) 28" Cherry S54°W 60.35 to remon tag on NW Side
 - 6) 34" Cherry S70°W 98.33 to remon tag on N'ly Side
 - 7) Remains of footing to SE corner of Barn N41°W 67.2
 - 9) Re-rod surrounded by rocks South 33.14
 - 10) Utility pole N2°E 22.43 to remon tag on E. Side
 - 11) Utility pole S2°E 47.84 to remon tag on W. Side
 - 12) Concrete monument South 43.00
 - 13) South face of West end concrete curb (buried) North 0.62
 - 14) Bent iron pipe (1st iron pipe as described in Section A, "Grid Book, No Date") S45°E 8.08

I conclude after careful study of the record documentation and field observation, that this corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
