

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing comer:

Found 1/2" Iron Pipe 6" below gravel surface inside of 1" Iron Pipe 12" below gravel surface. The 1" Iron Pipe was surrounded by large rocks. Set a 3/4" Iron Pipe with an Aluminum Remonumentation Cap stamped 24620 over the 1/2" Iron Pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

3/4" Iron Pipe with Remon Cap stamped 24620 over a 1/2" Iron Pipe that is inside a 1" Iron Pipe surrounded by large rocks.
