U.S. GOVERNMENT NOTES (1816) SET 1/4 POST
CYPRESS 14° S 26°E 13 LINKS (1) (GONE)
CYPRESS 9° N 27°E 27 LINKS (2) (GONE)

THERE IS NO EVIDENCE THAT THIS CORNER HAS EVER BEEN RESET.

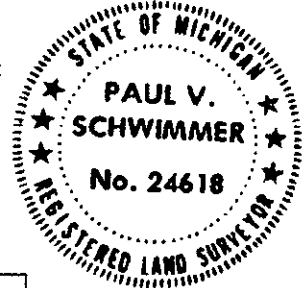
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I SET THIS CORNER BY SINGLE PROPORTIONAL MEASUREMENT BETWEEN THE S.E. CORNER OF SECTION 13 AND THE N.E. CORNER OF SECTION 13. THE POSITION FELL AT THE WEST EDGE OF AN EXISTING DRAIN. I SET TWO 2" X 18" IRON PIPES, ONE ON TOP OF THE OTHER, WITH THE TOP IRON BEING CAPPED WITH AN ALUMINUM REMONUMENTATION CAP. THERE ARE NO AVAILABLE WITNESSES OF ANY SIZE WITHIN 1000' FEET OF THIS POSITION.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

M-6 EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13 SHARDON TOWNSHIP
SET 2" IRON WITH REMONUMENTATION CAP OVER 2" IRON AT THE WATER'S EDGE
N 30°E 26.56' 6' ELM WITH NAIL & REMON. TAG IN S-SIDE
N 65°E 22.12' 12' ELM WITH NAIL & REMON. TAG IN S-SIDE
S 70°E 17.36' 4' ELM WITH NAIL & REMON TAG IN W-SIDE (5)
S 40°E 20.63' 6' ELM WITH NAIL & REMON TAG IN S-SIDE (6)
