Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a 8" Boat Spike at the intersection of Schneider Road(paved) and Saline Waterworks Road(gravel). Removed Boat Spike and found a 1/2"x18" Iron Pipe 11" below surface of road. Removed the Iron Pipe and still obtained a very definite reading with a metal locator. The road has been built up in this area and a larger hale would be recessary to confirm the presence of the 2"x48" from Pipe set by W.J. Armstrong in 1932. I feel that furthur excavation is unnecessary as the continuous tracking of the supporting accessories indicates this position to have remained stable over the years. I set a 1"(ID) x24" Iron Pipe with a Remonumentation Cap stamped #13604 to road surface.
