IT WOULD SEEM SAFE TO ASSUME THAT THE ORIGINAL SNYDER NAIL WAS REPLACED BY A IRON ROD AND MONUMENT BOX DURING A PREVIOUS RECONSTRUCION OF US-112.

DURING MY REMONUMENTATION EFFORTS, AN ABUTTING LAND OWNER INFORMED ME THAT JOHN E. MAXON, R.L.S. HAD RECENTLY USED THIS CORNER. WE ALSO FOUND AN OLD 4' CONCRETE MONUMENT WITH A 1/2' IRON PIPE NORTHERLY AT 49.91 FEET.
