Found 3/4" iron pipe 3" below road surface. Offset and removed iron pipe. Found no other evidence of a corner manument. Iron pipe is 1.5' East of a North/South fence line to the South.

Found following accesssories:

3) Oak 36" N 30" W 24.45' to nail & disc in S. side.

4) Twin 12" Oak N 65" W 35.13' to nail & disc in S. side.

4) Triple Oak (15", 22", & 7") N 60" E 47.89' to nail & disc in S. side 15" ook, most westerly.

5) Triple Oak (15", 22", & 7") N 60" E 47.89' to nail & disc in S. side 15" ook, most westerly.
